In Year 2 we teach English, Phonics and Maths every morning.

All other subjects are in the afternoon.

Reading books and reading logs will come home each day - could you please sign whenever you read with your child.



Our Topics



In English, this half term we will be reading *The Jolly Postman* and focussing on letter formation, basic sentence punctuation and conjunctions.

Maths focusses on the number system and building confidence with number before moving onto calculation.

Wider curriculum topics are *Our Local Area* and *Animals Including Humans*

We'll be trying to ensure we have fun, because happy children learn better!
