# Routines



In Year 3 we teach Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar, Guided Reading, English, and Maths every morning using groups. (WOW! It's a lot isn't it?)

All other subjects are in the afternoon.

Homework tasks/spellings will be sent home on a Friday to be returned on Thursday. Spelling tests will be on Friday morning. Reading books will come home each day.



# Our Topics



In English, this half term we will be reading books by the author and illustrator Anthony Browne and focusing on illustrations conveying meaning and applying our SPAG learning.

Maths focusses on the number system and building confidence with number before moving onto more complex calculation.

Wider curriculum topics are, The Vikings, Keeping healthy, French and RE.

We'll be trying to ensure we have fun, because happy children learn better!
