Our Topics



In English, this half term we will be reading *Wolf Brother* and focussing on sentence structure, recapping the use of subordinate clauses and introducing relative clauses.

Maths focusses on developing place value knowledge in numbers up to millions before focussing on mental and written methods for calculations.

Wider curriculum topics are *The British Kings and Queens*, *Materials and changes in properties*, and map skills.

We'll be trying to ensure we have fun, because happy children learn better!
